This is a wine with aromas of dark chocolate, fennel seed, black cherry and oregano.

On the palate plush blueberry fruit with a classic mocha-choc tannin profile.

Pale straw in colour, this Viognier has aromas of honeysuckle, candied ginger & pineapple that typify this exotic variety. The palate is rich in texture and body thanks to wild yeast fermentation and ageing on lees, yet retains a refreshing quality that make it a pleasure to drink

20. Gavi del Comune di Gavi Nuove Quadro

An enticing nose of white peach and pear with hints of fresh lime and gooseberry. Fresh and zesty citrus notes and ripe peachy characters are balanced by crisp acidity and mineral notes leading to a textured complex finish

21. Maçon Lugny, Caves de Lugny

From the 163 hectares of vineyard located in the villages of Lugny,

Bissy & St-Gengoux-de-Scisse. Average vine age of 35 years and matured with its lees in stainless steel vats. Fresh and complex with flavours of white flowers and dried fruits. Great as an aperitif or with fish, seafood and light meats

27. Cotes De Provence, Domaine Saint Andrieu

34% Grenache, 25% Cinsault, 11% Syrah and 8% Mourvedre and a balance of Cabernet Sauvignon, Rolle, Carignan & Tibouren.

Pink Lychee, delicate nose with notes of peach and exotic fruits.

The palate is harmonious, balanced and offers a well-rounded wine with hints of white fruits.

28. Côtes du Rhône, Noble Dame des Treilles

Classic, well balanced and full-bodied with a good length, attractive in its spicy character

29. Pinotage, False Bay (Vegan Friendly)

Deep garnet colour. The nose includes intense fruit aromas, particularly black cherry and strawberries with hints of liquorice. The palate includes lovely wild fruit crumble flavours with a herbal note and a hint of chocolate supported by soft tannins.

30. Quinta da Alorna, Portugal, Reserve

Touriga nacional & cabernet Sauvignon, forestry & red berries flavours, intense purple colour

31. Pig in a Poke

A fun created wine at its best. Well balanced of Merlot & Cabernet with fruity finish

32. Châteaux Timberlay Rouge, Bordeaux Supérieur

Unusual for such an inexpensive wine, it is aged in oak, yielding a relatively soft style with depth and character

33. Yalumba Y Series Merlot (Vegan Friendly)

This Merlot has classic aromas of black currants, spiced fruit cake, violets and vanilla lead to a medium bodied palate with flavours ranging from fruit cake to black cherry with very fine almost velvet tannins. The generous fruit flavours give the wine a fleshy, supple appeal that the variety is so well known for

34. Yalumba Organic Shiraz (Vegan Friendly)

Plums, peppercorn and spice complement intense fruit flavours, finishing savoury and soft. This is a medium bodied wine with plush soft tannins and best enjoyed young

35. Fleurie, Cave de Fleurie

With strawberry, raspberry and red cherry notes on the nose and silky tannins, this is an ideal partner to pates, cured meats or cheeses

36. Siglo Saco Crianza, Rioja Spain

Deep garnet-red colours, soft tannins with a long finish on a hint of Vanilla

37. 1884 Reservado, Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina

Deep red purple colour, intense black fruit aromas combined with a hint of mocha. Tannins are smooth and sweet, round and persistent finish

38. Taringi Pinot Noir

Rich on the nose with subtle hints of raspberries and cherries. Smooth, soft and mellow on the palate with Autumn fruit flavours.

This is a lovely Pinot Noir, great value for money and well worth a try
